Day 1: Prayer for revival in Highland Falls and West Point.

PRAY that:

- God would flood the grounds with a spirit of praise and prayer, erupting in your life, the lives of your family, and of those in service to this mission (Psalm 103).
- God would create opportunities and open doors in such a supernatural way that unbelievers would desire to know Him (Acts 8:26-40; 1 Corinthians 16:9).
- Ministry to the lost, hurt and broken would spread as a healing balm through Jesus Christ to the wounds of the community, letting them know that Jesus is available to them (Jeremiah 8:22; Mark 2:17).

Day 2: Prayer for a supernatural response of financial generosity to our “LET’S GO” opportunity to Highland Falls and West Point.

PRAY that:

- God would reveal specifically how you/your family can financially participate in our LET’S GO mission opportunity, to launch GCC Highland Falls (Matthew 6:33; 2 Corinthians 8 & 9).
- God would stir your heart and others’ to give cheerfully and expectantly (2 Corinthians 9:7; Luke 6:38).
- God would move in the hearts of those who have an abundance of financial resources to give lavishly to GCC Highland Falls (Deut. 8:18; Proverbs 3:9-10).

Day 3: Prayer for a covering against spiritual attack against GCC, the campus, and those in leadership and serving.

PRAY that:

- God's Hand of protection would be upon the church, every member, every leader and every volunteer and that no weapon forged against us will prevail (Isaiah 54:17; 2 Thessalonians 3:3).
- God would continually remind you/us that our victory is not by might, nor by power, but by His Spirit alone (Zechariah 4:6; Psalm 44:3).
- God would continually remind you/us that our warfare is not with flesh and blood, but with dark spiritual forces, and that prayer and His Word bring victory (2 Corinthians 10:4-5; Ephesians 6:10-18).

Day 4: Prayer for a surge of volunteers and leaders to fill every opening needed to launch and sustain the Highland Falls campus.

PRAY that:

- God will specifically reveal to you/your family if or how you might serve GCC Highland Falls, impacting the West Point community and beyond (1 Peter 4:10; John 13:1-17).
- God would multiply gospel workers for the sake of all ministry needs which exist now—and the needs to come (Matthew 9:35-38).
- God would use your trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, and your personal story as glorious instruments of restoration in the lives of His people (John 4:39; Revelation 12:11).

Day 5: Prayer for a spirit of unity which perfectly aligns our work with the will of God for Highland Falls and West Point.

PRAY that:

- There will be such a spirit of oneness and unity within GCC that others will see and marvel, and thereby believe that God sent Jesus to save them (John 15:17; John 17).
- GCC will unite together in such harmony that we experience how good and pleasant it is, and enjoy the blessing and life God bestows because of it (Psalm 133).
- That above all it is God's love, God's gospel, and God's mission in and through GCC that unites us (John 13:34-35; Matt 28:16-20).

Day 6: An awakening of heart and minds in and around Highland Falls and West Point as God prepares the ground for ministry.

PRAY that:

- Seeds of ministry would be planted, watered, and increased for the sake of those living in poverty, under addiction, suffering through depression, mental illness, for prison populations, and the orphaned and widowed (1 Corinthians 3:6; James 1:27).
- God would show you personally where and how to minister to His people in ways that lovingly draw them to the Cross (Matthew 5:13-16).
- God will do immeasurably more than all we can ask or imagine according to His power at work within us (Ephesians 3:14-21).

Day 7: A passionate desire for and commitment to prayer to serve as the foundation for GCC Highland Falls, impacting the West Point community and beyond.

PRAY that:

- A spirit of prayer and intercession would take root in and through this open door, moving on the hearts of volunteers, leaders and their families (1 Timothy 2:1; 1 Thessalonians 1:2).
- God would call prayer warriors to this ministry who serve through unceasing prayer and supplication, according to God's Word and His will (1 Thessalonians 5:17; Ephesians 6:18).
- We be compelled to ask, seek, knock in prayer to God knowing He desires to give good gifts, namely the filling and favor of the Holy Spirit for those who ask Him (Matthew 7:11; Luke 11:13).
